Responsibilities

The Great Plains Switch Job is responsible for providing safe and reliable rail service to the park customers. Duties include:

- The operation of all railroad equipment at safe and effective speeds.
- Pickup and delivery of freight cars as defined in the daily switch list. When derrails are removed, they must be locked back on the rails to protect employees and equipment.
- Ensure cars are not temporarily stored or placed on industry trackage. This trackage is private property and must not be used by Great Plains for car movements.
- Verification of work completed before the end of shift to ensure complete customer satisfaction.
- Strict compliance to all rules and regulations as defined by class 1 railroads, such as the BNSF.
- Operation and maintenance of all equipment to ensure safety and reliability. Asset protection is a priority.
